Play time

Gather any blocks you have—they can be wooden, foam or even Lego. Work with your child to build a wall using the blocks.

Introduce the story

Great job building the wall! Today you will hear a story about Nehemiah. He was sad because the walls and gates around Jerusalem were broken. The king allowed Nehemiah to go home to Jerusalem to rebuild the city. Nehemiah led God's people to rebuild the walls around the city. Will Himself restore you." (make a happy face)


