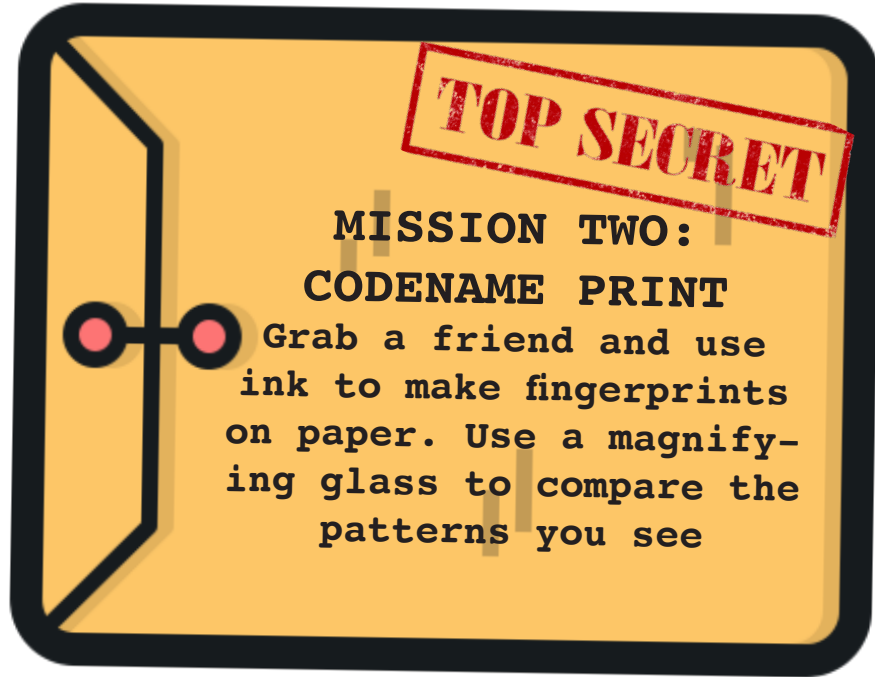
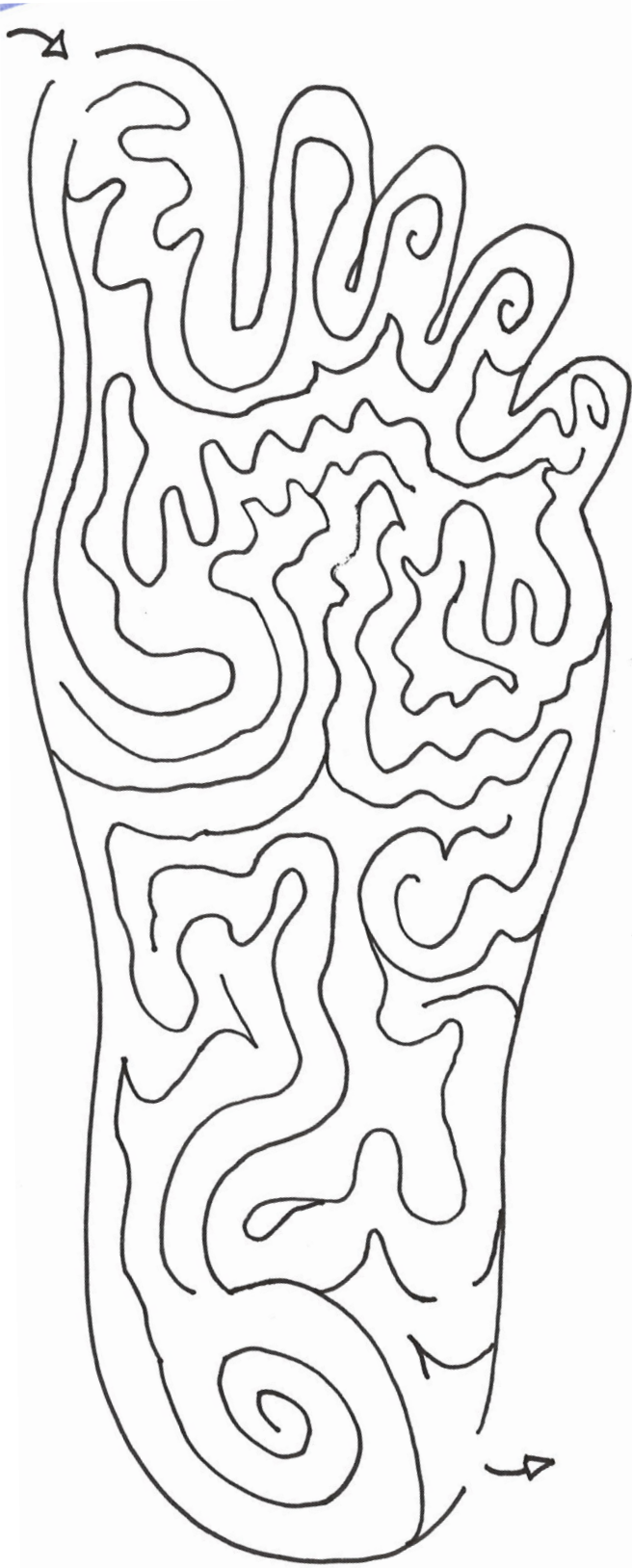
Reagent Mixture:

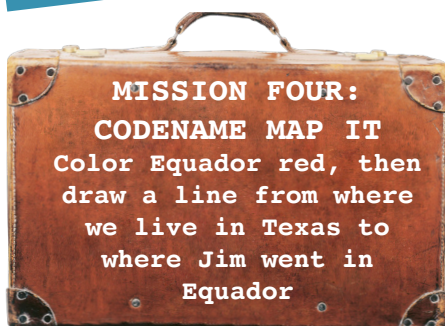

Eric Liddell was a runner in the Olympics. He was supposed to run on a Sunday, but he believed that Sunday was a day to worship and honor God and refused to run on that day. He ran races on other days and God blessed his performance, allowing him to win gold and bronze. Later in his life, he taught people about Jesus in China. He died there in a prison camp.
