

side.





Edible Rocks


supplies: popcorn,


Do you have a best friend? Write down their name here.

What would you think if you woke up and saw Jesus talking to Elijah and Moses?


Peter asked if they should build them a shelter to stay in. What question would you ask?






Picnic Pinwheels



Draw what Peter's face might have looked like when he realized that it was Jesus calling to them from the shore.






