





supplies: ruler, pencil


We can use a ruler to measure a lot of things, but God's love for us is so big that we can't measure it. Use the ruler to measure each area of your body and fill in the blanks.


A Prayer for When I'm Scared

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





Resurrection Rolls

supplies: crescent rolls, butter, brown sugar, cinnamon, 8 regular marshmallows

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees Fahrenheit. Melt 1/4 cup of butter in the microwave. While the butter melts, combine 2 Tbs of brown sugar and 2 tsp of cinnamon in a bowl. Dip the marshmallows in the melted butter, then roll them in the cinnamon sugar mixture. Wrap each marshmallow in a triangle of the crescent dough and bake for 10-13 minutes. When they come out of the oven, talk about the marshmallow disappearing and how it represents Jesus' death and resurrection and how he's coming back soon.


God's Promises Book/Comic
