Through wisdom, praise, thanksgiving, lament and trust, each chapter is a God-centered chorus, ultimately pointing to our faithful King, Jesus Christ. Our study in God's hymnbook is sure to strengthen our hearts with greater faith and open our eyes to the greatness of our Savior.

As we study Psalms together as a church, we've broken our discipleship challenge into two parts highlighting prayer and worship. Part one will focus on the purpose of prayer, different types of prayer, and a practical application of prayer.

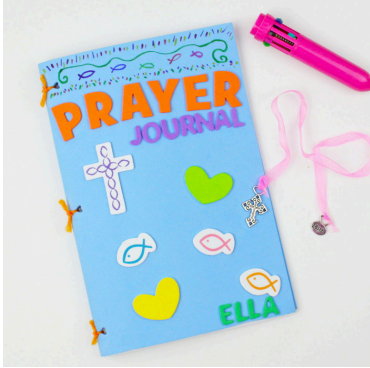

# Prayer Journal Setup



## Make a Prayer Journal:



To start off this Discipleship Challenge, create a prayer journal using the final two pages of this packet. **You will need to bring the prayer journal along with the completed Discipleship Challenge in order to earn tokens.** Anytime you see the yellow journal symbol, follow the directions to write in your prayer journal.

*Supplies: the last two pages of this packet (pulled out), construction paper, crayons, markers, stickers, misc. decoration supplies, stapler*

### Instructions:

1. Carefully pull the last two pages out of the Discipleship Challenge.
2. Fold them in half.
3. Fold a single sheet of construction paper in half the same way you did the other pages.
4. Staple the construction paper to the outside of the other papers to create a cover for the prayer journal.
5. Decorate with crayons, markers, stickers, etc.




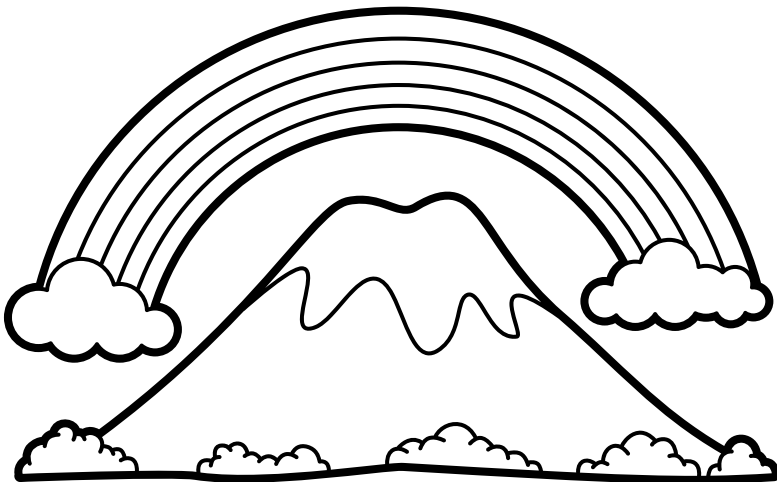

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A lament is a prayer of deep sadness or sorrow. What does the writer of this Psalm do when he feels deeply sad?

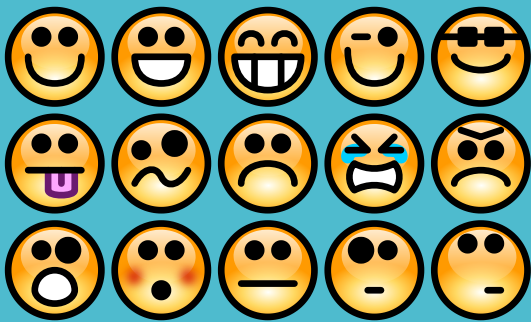

# Types of Prayer - Repentance

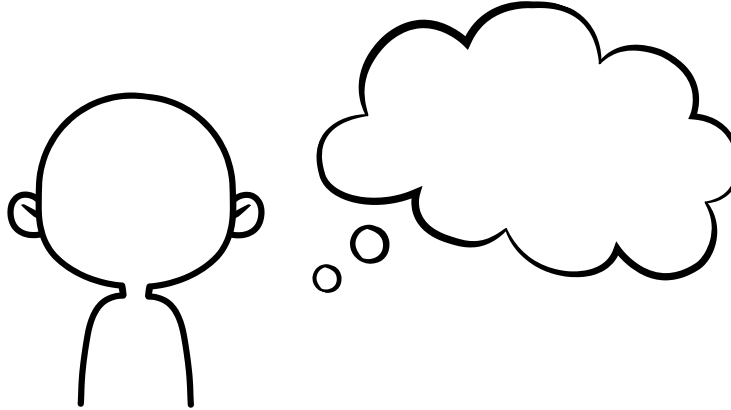
Read Psalm 51. Next, answer the questions below.
