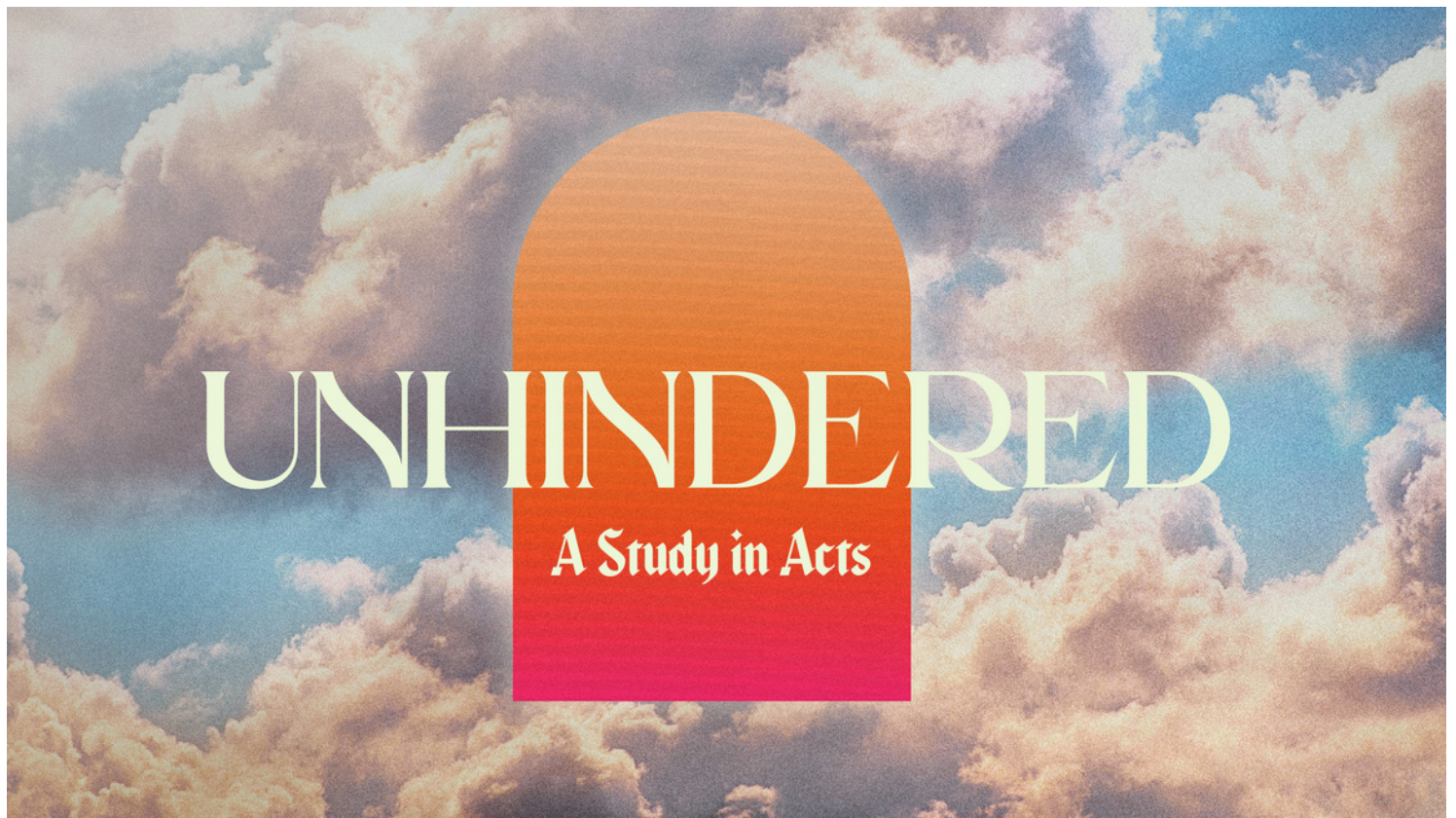




Unhindered

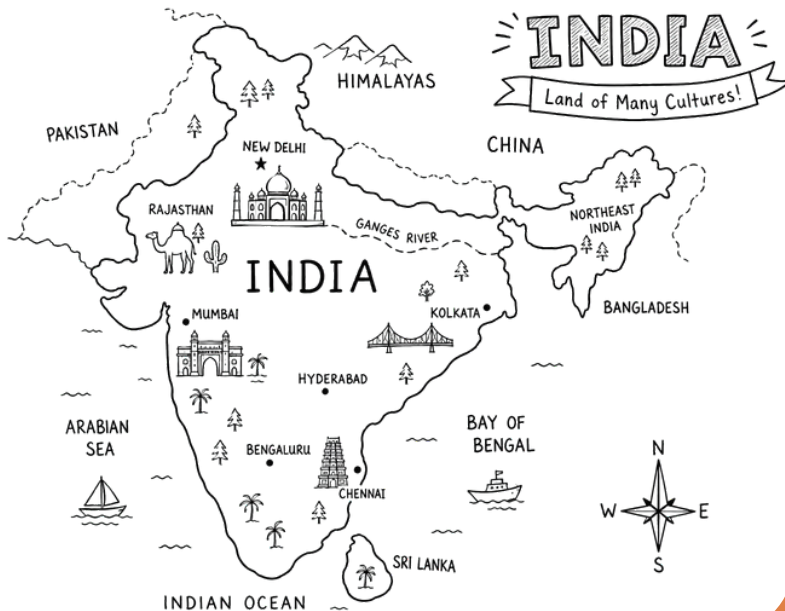

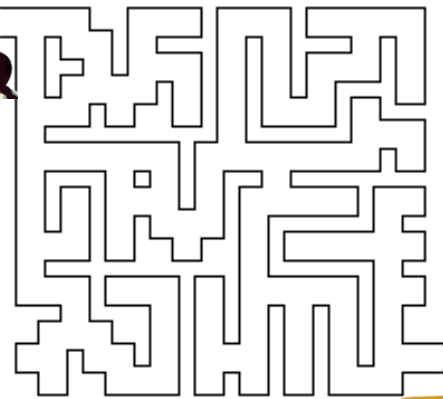

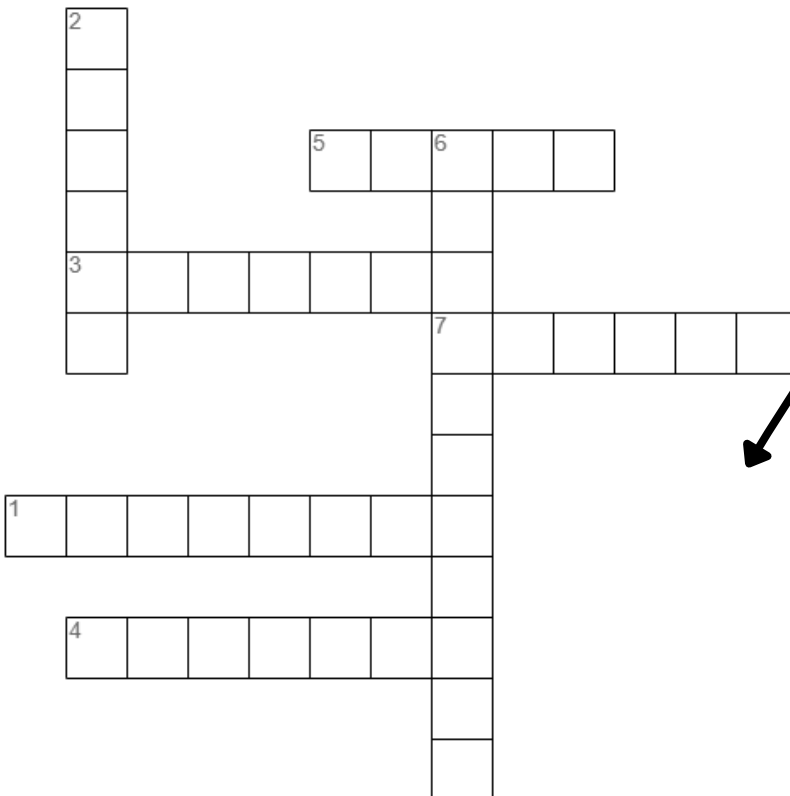
CHOOSE FORGIVENESS
