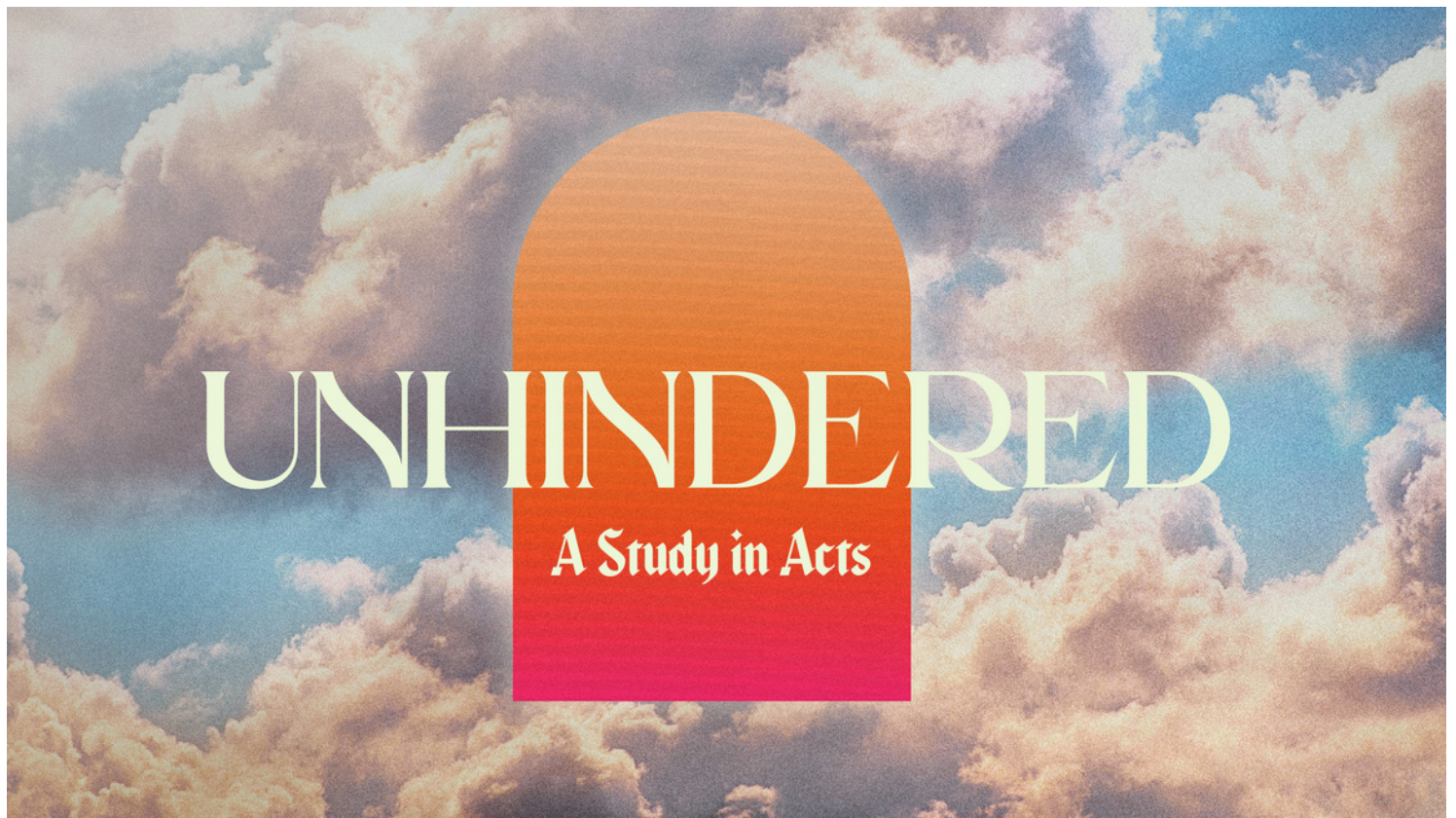




Unhindered

On Mission

What is a missionary? A missionary is a Christian who obeys God's call to tell people about Jesus. Some missionaries travel across oceans to share the gospel. Others serve in the place where they already live.

Missionaries do all kinds of things. They start new churches, translate the English Bible into a language for another country, teach children about Jesus, care for people with medical needs, or help others learn about God's love. Every Christian is called to share the good news of Jesus wherever God has placed them.

JIM ELLIOT'S MISSION MAP

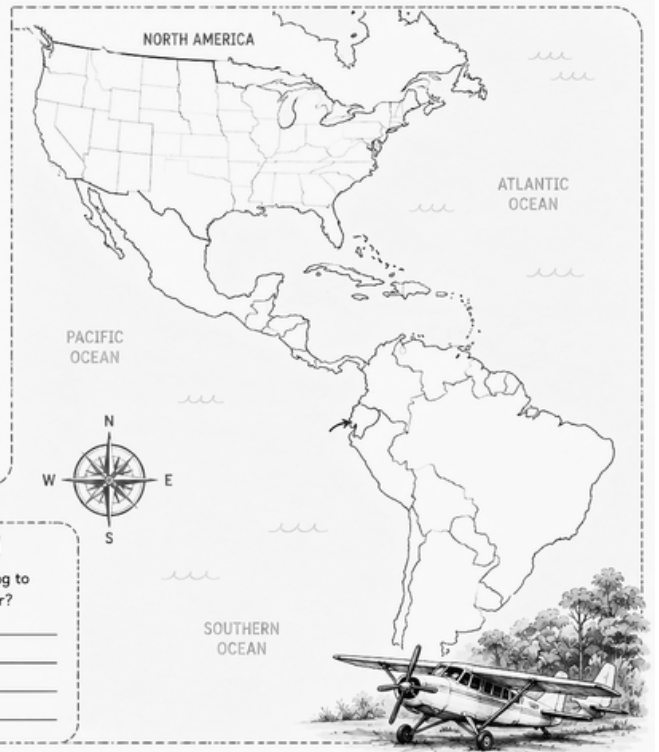
He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep to gain what he cannot lose.

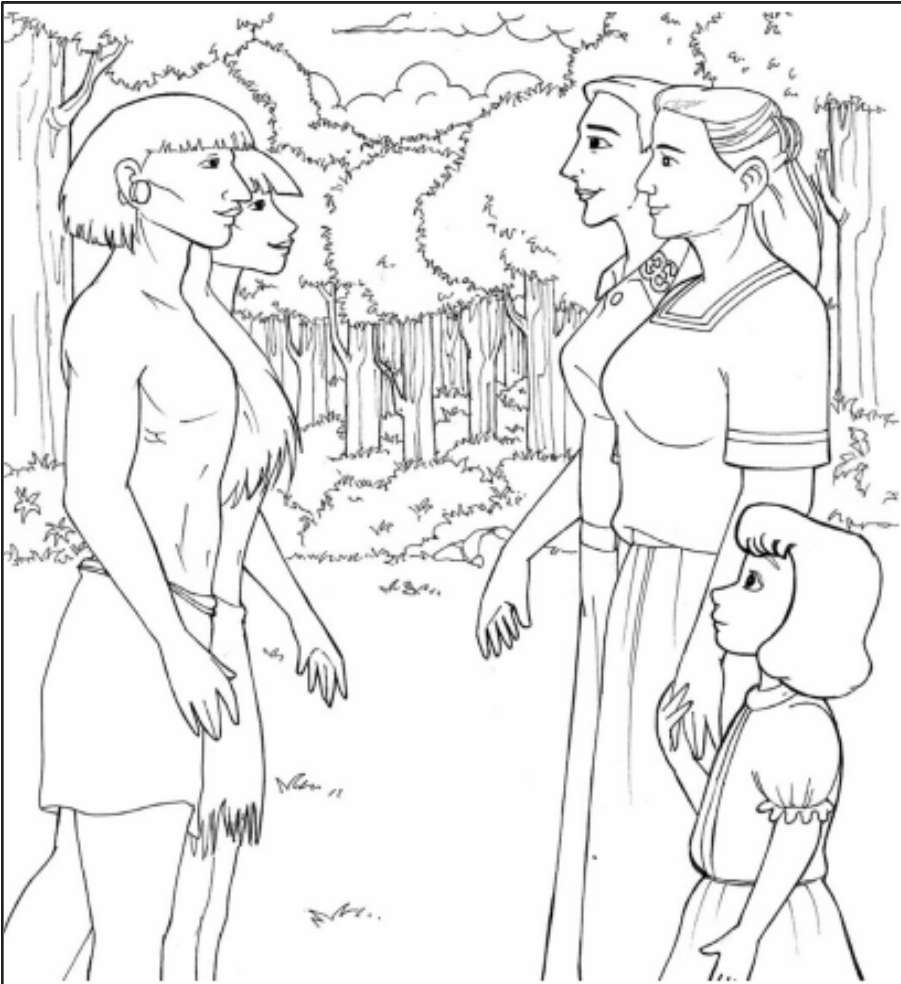
